What The Digital Transition Means To You...

After February 17, 2009, a television receiver with only an analog broadcast tuner will require a converter box to receive over-the-air broadcasts with an antenna because of the nation's transition to digital broadcasting. Analog-only TVs should continue to work as before with cable and satellite TV services, gaming consoles, VCRs, DVD players and similar products.

If you own a television with a digital tuner or subscribe to a cable TV service like TriCounty Telecom, you will probably notice very little change in the way you receive TV programming after the transition. TriCounty Telecom will have all necessary equipment for you to continue watching the local networks on your current television sets. If, however, you have TVs in your home receiving broadcast signals using a **rooftop antenna** or **rabbit ears**, you will have to make some adjustments. Either you will have to obtain a converter box to convert the digital signal to analog, purchase a digital television set with an integrated digital tuner or connect those TVs to TriCounty Telecom cable TV service. **Please note:** You would only need to take action before February 17, 2009, if you currently watch TV on an analog TV set that **is not** connected to cable, satellite or other pay TV service.

Parental Locks allow you to restrict viewing of TV programming based on your viewing preferences. Set a personalized 4-digit PIN and you can place Locks on selected ratings, channels and titles. You can also hide adult titles from being displayed on screen.

Set and change your **Parental Locks PIN in PINs Setup**. Using your cable receiver remote control:

- Press **Menu** twice
- Select **Setup**
- Select **PINs Setup**
- Follow the on-screen prompts to setup, clear or change your **PIN**

Set Locks by using the lock icon on an information screen, by going to **Parental Controls** from the Main Menu or select **Setup** from the Main Menu, then **Locks Setup**. Use the arrow keys to make your selections, then press **OK** to confirm each setting.
